Moving forward, Primax take conflict minerals inspection as due diligent, will follow upcoming agenda, dynamically adopt necessary actions, continue initiates and engage with its suppliers. Primax as a leading company expect to realize global human right protection raising through supporting Responsible Minerals Policy.

Primax's commitments:

1. Primax will not purchase products containing minerals (such as tantalum (Ta), tin (Sn), tungsten (W) and gold (Au) cobalt (Co), mica...) mining from human rights violations areas, etc.
2. Primax purchase 3TG materials from Conflict-Free smelters validated by CFSP or equivalent certification, and do not prohibit qualified materials from Democratic Republic of the Congo and its surrounding countries.
3. Primax follow OECD DDG standards with due diligence to perform supplier management and risk mitigation.
4. Primax request its suppliers follow same commitments listed above, and engage their upstream suppliers' to join us and follow the same.
